V Long Range Projects:

Fencing/Netting: Carl spoke about fencing, that it should be covered by the school. He would like the low fence in front of the visitor bleachers to go almost all the way to the fence and the home fence down past the bleachers. Netting along Nina's would also be the school's responsibility. The baseball netting wasn't put up last year. There was a small amount of vandalism on the netting.

Storage Facility: The price we had was for 1 facility. The advantages in doing 2 are paying the supervisor only once, ordering supplies only once, costs go up, some labor costs lesser for 2 at once. There are gutters, door at north end, trusses run E & W. It takes 3-4 weeks to order trusses. It will take 6 people 3 to 4 weekends to finish. Greg may look into getting products donated. It will be about 12 weeks time from agreeing to build to finishing the buildings. Rick Staver brought up an idea to do both cement slabs and just one building for now. A motion was made and passed to completely build one storage building and to pour the slab only for the 2nd building. We want to be sure to keep a roof over the girls' bench for the entire season. Greg suggested pouring the slabs during the season and building the building during the summer. No decision was reached. In April Greg will bring a bigger drawing with line items figured out. He will try to get JD to come to help explain. Questions: Can we have someone donate time for tax write-off?

Margie will notify John Spenser of the building.

Thank-you Signage: Kathy Howland brought a mock-up of the thank-you signs. We may want to leave space on the sign for any further donations.

Shutters for Concession Stand: Gary Vincent brought a proposal for concession stand shutters. Discussion resulting in doing something that would cost less, perhaps using plywood put up on the outside of the building and more durable locks. There was no timeframe decided for this.
