

2009 WMU High School Girls Team Camp

When: February 28-March 8

Where: WMU Seelye Center
Directions From I-94 At exit #74, turn north onto US-131, go 2.7 miles; use the following directions for exiting from US-131. Exit #36 (Stadium Drive East) and proceed 2.5 miles. After crossing Oliver Street (in between basketball arena and softball field), the second right will be the entrance (Lot 7) to the Seelye Center.

Cost: \$75 per player
Teams must have a minimum of 14 players with at least 1 goalkeeper and a maximum of 22 players. If you are an individual without a team, we will place you on one that is in need of players. Camp is open to all female players in grade 9-12. However, we only have room for 24 teams, so spots will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.

Format: Each team will get two 90-minute training sessions, which will include both individual and team instruction. Each training session will be coached by one of the staff coaches. Team contacts will be emailed training dates and times by a WMU soccer staff member. Each team will also play in three 40-minute games. The games will be played 9v9 (8 plus GK). Games are played on March 7 and March 8 throughout the day. Game schedules will be created by the WMU staff and handed out after each team's second training session.

The facility has a 3rd floor viewing area as well as viewing area on the playing level
